Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 22188 Certificate No. 7408

1. The source of water is an underground source in Indian Springs Valley Ground Water Basin.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 cfs

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 11, Township 16 South, Range 55 1/2 East, M.D.B. & M.,

Clark County, Nevada or at a point from which the Northeast Corner of Section 11 bears North 39°47'18" East a distance of 801.68 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 11, Township 16 South, Range 55 1/2 East, M.D.B. & M.,

or at a point from which the Northeast Corner of Section 11 bears North 13°09'27" East a distance of 2085.28 feet.

7. Proposed place of use is a portion of the SW 1/4, SW 1/4, of Section 1, a portion of the SE 1/4, SE 1/4 of Section 2; a portion of the NE 1/4, NE 1/4, of Section 11 and a portion of the

NW 1/4, NW 1/4, of Section 12, all in Township 16 South, Range 55 1/2 East, M.D.B. & M., Clark County, Nevada.

8. Existing place of use is the East Half (E 1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 11, Township 16 South, Range 55 1/2 East, M.D.B. & M., Clark County, Nevada.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) The proposed Point of Diversion is an existing well, and steel casing drilled by Great Basin Drilling

12. Estimated cost of works Ten Thousand Dollars

13. Estimated time required to construct works Two years to complete the water system, and construct the new truck stop

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Seven years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

Water shall not exceed 0.05 cfs not to exceed 36.20 acre feet per year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 22188, Certificate 7408 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 22188, Certificate 7408 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well drilled under Permit 22188, Certificate 7408 shall be plugged in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code 534.420 within 60 days from the issuance of Permit 61082.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 36.2 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 5, 1997

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 5, 1997

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 5, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 5, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
