The applicant City of Las Vegas

Nevada 89101 hereby make S. application for permission to change the

point of diversion, manner of use and place of use
of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 52380.

1. The source of water is Underground

2. The amount of water to be changed .012 cfs, but not to exceed 8.5 acre-feet per annum.

3. The water to be used for Municipal and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for Recreation and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 2, T.21S., R.60E., M.D.B. & M.,
or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 2 bears N. 09°37'29" W.,
a distance of 771.94 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 NE 1/4, of Section 32, Township 20
South, Range 60 East, M.D.B. & M., at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said
Sec. 32 bears North 59°57' West, 375 feet.

7. Proposed place of use is the area described within the Las Vegas Valley Water District
as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it
may hereafter be amended. (Map filed under Permit 53732)

8. Existing place of use E 1/2 Section 29, N 1/2 N 1/2, Section 31 and N 1/2 N 1/2 Section 32, T.20S.,
R.60E., M.D.B. & M., excepting that portion of the E 1/2 of Section 29 lying within
the proposed right of way for Summerlin Parkway.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and
specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water is to be diverted from a 20-inch
deep, known as District Well No. 89, via deep well pump, pipelines, reservoirs, and distribution system.

12. Estimated cost of works \$1.0 million

13. Estimated time required to construct works Well No. 89 is already pumping.

- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use. Immediately after approval of this application.
- 15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

The application to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use moves 8.5 acre-feet per annum from Angel Park to District Well No. 89 pursuant to an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and the Las Vegas Valley Water District. Well No. 89 is the same point of diversion as Permit No. 58893.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52380 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52380 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The existing well under Permits 36041, 48886 and 52380 shall be plugged as required by NAC 534.420 immediately upon the issuance of Permits 61282, 61283 and 61284.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.012 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.77 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 27, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 27, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 27, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 27, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

Proof of beneficial use filed OCT 23 1997
