Nevada 89106, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is. underground

2. The amount of water applied for is. 138 cfs or 100 acre-feet per year

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet.

3. The water to be used for. Emergency Fire Suppression

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated.

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered.

(2) Point of return of water to stream.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point. located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T.22S., R.57E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of said Section 29, bears N 79°34'10" E, a distance of 1,343.78 feet.

6. Place of use. Mountain Springs Area of Southern Nevada being T.22S., R.57E.; T.22S., R.58E.; T.23S., R.57E.; T.23S., R.58E.; all located within Clark County, Nevada.

7. Use will begin about. January 1 and end about. December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) water is to be diverted from a 12-inch diameter cased well approximately 660 feet deep, via well pump, pipelines and storage tank.

- 9. Estimated cost of works... \$50,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works... Two (2) Years  
If well completed, describe works.
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use... Five (5) Years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

The application to appropriate water from an existing well, currently utilized under waiver C-143, and will be used to fill a large storage tank for emergency fire suppression around the Mountain Springs Area.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.  
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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.138 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually.

- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 4, 1999
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 4, 1999
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 4, 2002
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 4, 2002
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

This permit is issued for emergency fire protection which includes the operation of any facility at this location and periodic testing of the well. However, in the event of actual fire protection use, the amount of water granted will be the amount necessary for the purpose.
