1. The source of water is underground-Las Vegas Valley Ground-Water Basin

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 8 bears N. 77°16'51" E., a distance of 398.77 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 23 bears N. 79°24'05" W., a distance of 703.89 feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 55883 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 55883 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.07 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 50.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 14, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 14, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 14, 1997

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 14, 1997

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
