The applicant Robert D. Stitser, hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion, place of use, manner of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 56440

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.1667 second feet, 45.827 acre-feet
3. The water to be used for irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for commercial
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point T35N, R37E, MDB&M, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, from the Section Corner S7/S8/S17/S18: N26°W, 287.23 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within T35N, R37E, MDB&M, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 9, from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor S9/S10: S21°29'14"W, 1,112.98 feet.
7. Proposed place of use T35N, R37E, MDB&M, Portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and Portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7. Area to be irrigated: 34.37 acres.
8. Existing place of use T35N, R37E, MDB&M, Portion NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 9.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Works to consist of one (1) underground well with twelve inch casing to an approximate depth of 150 feet.
12. Estimated cost of works \$4,500
13. Estimated time required to construct works One (1) year.
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use One (1) year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56440 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56440 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 61805, 61806 and 61807 shall not exceed 137.48 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 34.37 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Proof 02867 and Permits 61805, 61806 and 61807 shall not exceed 325.48 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1667 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 45.827 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 24, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

July 24, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 24, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 24, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 24, 2000
