The applicant **Barbara L. Flanagan, Trustee of the Barbara L. Flanagan Living Trust Dated March 19, 1991**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 56288**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0367 c.f.s., 9.36 acre-feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T.13 N., R.20 E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 35 bears South 19°21' West, 1735 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T.12 N., R.21 E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 13 bears North 22°46' West, 1126 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T.13 N., R.20 E., MDB&M**
8. Existing place of use **within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.12 N., R.21 E., MDB&M. 10.0 acres total to be removed from irrigation under this application as shown on the supporting map**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, pump and motor, and irrigation distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$25,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **well complete**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56288 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56288 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 61895, 61896 and 61897 shall not exceed 40.0 acre-feet annually.

Permits 61895, 61896 and 61897 will be limited to the irrigation of 10.0 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.033 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 8.416 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 24, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

July 24, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 24, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 24, 1999


