The applicant Gene Kohltfarber and Julia A. Kohltfarber, hereby makes application for permission to change the place of use and the manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Truckee Carson Irrigation District Serial No. 528-1-2, United States of America v. Orr Ditch Co. in Equity No. A-3, Claim No. 3; United States of America v. Alpine Land and Reservoir Co., No. D-183 BRT; both in the Federal District Court of Nevada.

1. The source of water is Truckee and Carson Rivers
2. The amount of water to be changed 100.76 acre-feet (33.70 acres @ 2.99 acre-feet per acre)
3. The water to be used for Maintainance of Wetlands for Recreation and Wildlife/Storage
4. The water heretofore permitted for As decreed.
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Lahontan Dam, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T19N, R26E, M.D.B.&M.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within No change.
7. Proposed place of use 77,364 acres - more or less - as described in Exhibit A, and as shown on map for File No. 57748, which map is incorporated by reference.
8. Existing place of use 33.70 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T19N, R28E, M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from As decreed.
10. Use was permitted from As decreed.
11. Description of proposed works No new diversion or storage works on the Truckee River and the Carson River will be constructed.
12. Estimated cost of works N/A

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 1 year
15. Remarks: Applicant expressly reserves the right to transfer in a later proceeding: 0.51 acre-feet for each of the 33.70 acres from which the 2.99 acre-feet per acre are to be transferred by this application.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place and manner of use of the waters of the Truckee and Carson Rivers as set forth under the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decrees and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit is expressly contingent on the payment of the operation and maintenance charges that are properly assessed and come due the same as if the water right were still appurtenant to the agricultural land from which it is transferred, pursuant to NRS 533.370, subsection 1(b).

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on November 15, 1996 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 100.76 acre-feet as decreed.


