The applicant **Great Basin Construction Company**, a Nevada Corporation, hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use. of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Claim #628 of the Truckee River Decree said decree entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled, "The United States of America, Plaintiff, vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al, Defendants", in equity docket A-3.

1. The source of water is **Truckee River**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.42 cfs - 50.00 acre feet**
3. The water to be used for **municipal and domestic purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **as decreed purposes**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **See Exhibit "A"**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The NW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 32, T20N, R22E, MDM, from which point the east quarter corner of said Section 32 bears S 55°50' E, a distance of 3,240.00 feet.**

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 628, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.417 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 50.0 acre-feet as decreed.



The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, T. 19N., R. 18E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T. 19N., R. 18E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10, T. 19N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, T. 19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, T. 19N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.

ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, T. 19N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, Nevada; from said point of diversion the Southwest corner of said Section 17 bears South 44°40' West, a distance of 3,211.00 feet.




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
