The applicant Sierra Pacific Power Company, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place and Manner of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 17585, Certificate 5678

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 30 acre-feet, 0.05 cfs
3. The water to be used for Construction purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for Municipal
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 6, T.18N., R.20E., bears South 12°28'15" East, a distance of 5,443.0 feet (GOB Truck-fill Station).
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 4 bears S. 48°31'W., a distance of 991.87 feet (Stanford Well).
7. Proposed place of use the certificated water service area of Sierra Pacific Power Company as described in the legal description and shown on the supporting map on file with the State Engineer's Office, Carson City, Nevada.
8. Existing place of use within the Sections 4 and 5, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from May 1, 1996 to April 30, 1997 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Water is pumped from the SPPCo building basement and existing dewatering basins to existing ponds, then to construction water trucks.
12. Estimated cost of works \$50,000 (existing)
13. Estimated time required to construct works Existing portable truck-fill water station
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use one (1) year
15. Remarks: Sierra Pacific Power Company is applying for a temporary permit to supply contractors. This action is for compliance to a Nevada Public Service Commission order. Water rights for this permit are from the SPPCo Stanford Well. This is a temporary application. This application is for an extension of Permit 60422-T

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 17585 Certificate 5678 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17585 Certificate 5678 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on August 7, 1997 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is subject to the combined duty of 12,000.0 acre-feet annually indicated in the letter from Pete Morros, State Engineer, dated February 13, 1986.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 30.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
