The applicant **Michael B. Stewart**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 20165, Certificate 7258**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **2.0 c.f.s. (Not to exceed 1232.0 AFA)**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Lot 6 Section 1, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M** or at a point from which the **NE corner Section 7, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M** bears **S.68°39'9"E.** a distance of **11,232.9 ft.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE¼ SE¼ Section 36, T.36N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.**, or at a point from which the **SE corner of said Section 36** bears **S.2°37'00"E.** at a distance of **987.0 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **No Change**
8. Existing place of use **NW¼ SE¼ (40.6 acres), SW¼ SE¼ (40 acres), SE¼ SE¼ (38.6 acres), Section 36, T.36N, R.23E, M.D.B.&M. and Lot 1 (14.4 acres), Lot 2 (14.4 acres), SE¼ (160 acres) Section 2, T.35N, R.23E., M.D.B.&M. Total of 308.0 Acres**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled & Cased Well, Pump, Motor, and Distribution System.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$50,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Well Completed Under 61151T Drilled and Cased 14 inch well to a depth of 540 feet.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **five (5) years**

The total combined duty of water under Permit 23493, Certificate 6568 and this Application shall not exceed 1232.0 afa. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 20165, Certificate 7258 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 20165, Certificate 7258 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 23493, Certificate 6568; 20165, Certificate 7258; 62250-T shall not exceed 1,232.0 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on July 22, 1997 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1,232.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
