The applicant **Washoe County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Nevada**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 41662**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 41662 which changed the place of use and manner of use of Claim No. 716, Truckee River Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued subject to the permittee providing for any head loss, if any, of the other Howards Creek users due to this permit and also subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on November 7, 1997 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.313 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 50.0 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:


