The applicant Tehama Holdings, Inc., hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place & Manner of Use of water heretofore appropriated under portion of Permit No. 23888 Certificate 8283

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.6280 cfs 164.60 acre feet annually
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 22 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian at a point from which the north $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 8 bears North 54 28'00" West, 4600.00 feet. (Well WT-1) See Permit 55600.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M. at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec.5 bears South 65 13'05" West, 2,755.53 feet distant (Well No. 3)
7. Proposed place of use NE NW; NW NW; all in Section 9, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., a total of 41.15 Acres within the 80 acres described. See attached map.
8. Existing place of use SE SW, NW SE, SW SE, NE SE, SE SE Sec.5; NW NE, NE NE, NE NW, Sec.8; all in T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M. Total of 41.15 acres See attached copy of map from Permit 23888 for areas to be stripped.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from March 1 to October 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works exist. well, pump, pipeline, sprinkler irrigation system.
12. Estimated cost of works \$150,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works existing
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use within two weeks
15. Remarks: See Map No. 23888 for existing point of diversion and place of use. This application would allow temporary use of 164.6 acre feet of this right to grow row crops within NE NW and NW NW Sec 9, T22N., R21E., M.D.M. during the 1996 growing season. On property owned by Tehama Holdings, Inc. using Western Turf's Point of Diversion See map 65300.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23888 Certificate 8283 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23888 Certificate 8283 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 55600, 55608, 62389-T, 62390-T and 62391-T shall not exceed 1,052.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on September 10, 1997 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.628 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 164.60 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:


