APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins and before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0017 cubic feet per second or 1.23 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 8, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 8, 2010

7. Use will begin about MAY 15 and end about NOVEMBER 30, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works WELL DRILLED TO 70': 12" CASING; 3/4 HP BARKLAY PUMP TO 1000 FT OF DISTRIBUTION LINE
9. Estimated cost of works \$9,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works IN EXISTENCE SINCE AUGUST 1967
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use PUT TO USE CONTINUOUSLY SINCE 1967 UNDER THE FEDERAL RESERVE RIGHT
