This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of Thomas Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 41663 which changed the place and manner of use of Claim No. 720, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to the notification to Truckee-Carson Irrigation District by the permittee of any secondary applications filed under this primary permit. Truckee-Carson Irrigation District will have thirty (30) days from the receipt of such notice to file protests with the State Engineer.

Water measuring devices and totalizing meters must be installed and accurate records must be kept of the water diverted and placed into storage.

A monthly report of the water diverted and placed into storage must be submitted to the State Engineer and Federal Water Master on a monthly basis within 15 days after the end of each month.

This permit is issued subject to the regulation of the irrigation season as established by the Federal Water Master.

A substantial measuring device must be installed and accurate records must be kept of the water flowing in Thomas Creek prior to it's commingling with other drainages.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.6 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 94.18 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 16, 1999



The applicant **Washoe County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Nevada**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 41663**

1. The source of water is **Thomas Creek**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.6001 cfs, 94.18 acre-feet**
3. The water to be used for **Storage**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE¼ NW¼ Section 4, T.18N. R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 57° 24'41" W. a distance of 3050.064 ft.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE¼ SW¼ Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the center of Section 8, T.18N., R20E., M.D.B.&M bears N. 70°30'E. a distance of 6,550 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **To be determined under secondary permits. Storage reservoir is located within the NW¼ Section 4, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. and the SW¼ of Section 33, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.**

9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Headgates, Ditches and pipelines to Dam and Reservoir constructed under permit J-325.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$15,000,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed under Orr Ditch Decree and permits 55534 and J-325.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **to be determined under secondary permits**

This permit is issued for the consumptive use portion only of the original Truckee River Decree rights (Claim 720) that being 2.5 acre-feet per acre, the remaining portion of the claim will go to make up downstream rights.

Water measuring devices and totalizing meters must be installed and accurate records must be kept of the water diverted and placed into storage.

A monthly report of the water diverted and placed into storage must be submitted to the State Engineer and Federal Water Master on a monthly basis within 15 days after the end of each month.

This permit is issued subject to the regulation of the irrigation season as established by the Federal Water Master.

A substantial measuring device must be installed and accurate records must be kept of the water flowing in Thomas Creek prior to its commingling with other drainages.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.6 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 59.67 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before: May 16, 1999
