The applicant Michael B. Stewart, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner & Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 26963, Certificate 8432

1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.116 cfs, not to exceed 84 acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Quasi-municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.30N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 4, T.29N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 77°01'57"E., a distance of 17,380.0 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.30N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of said Section 1 bears N. 87°54' E., a distance of 1,370.0 feet
7. Proposed place of use Portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, all within Section 16, T.29N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.
8. Existing place of use 40 acres within Lot 7, 40 acres within Lot 8, 40 acres within Lot 9, 40 acres within Lot 10, 160 acres within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ all within Section 1, T.30N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. Area to be stripped is 7 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 14 acres within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T.30N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works drilled well, pump & motor & distribution system
12. Estimated cost of works Completed
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed under Permit 51890
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use one (1) year

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same; subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26963 Certificate 8432 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26963 Certificate 8432 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on February 25, 1998 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.116 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 84.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
