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The applicant **ROSEMOUNT WATER COMPANY, A NEVADA CORPORATION**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 23632, Certificate No. 8640**

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1. The source of water is **collection tank for 3 un-named springs**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.225 cfs, not to exceed 9,200,000 gallons annually**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Commercial Use**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T17N, R19E, M.D.M. or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 16 bears N 00°59' W, 817.2 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T17N, R19E, M.D.M., or at point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 17 bears N 15°43'19" E, a distance of 569.95 feet (Spring No. 4), N 12°18'17" E, a distance of 763.12 feet (Spring No. 5), and N 6°17'22" E, a distance of 841.72 feet (Spring No. 6).**
7. Proposed place of use **NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, all in T17N, R19E, M.D.M.**
8. Existing place of use **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, ALL in T17N, R19E, M.D.M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Existing Collection Tank, Pump and Storage Tank**
12. Estimated cost of works **None**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **None**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 Years**
15. Remarks: **The purpose of this change application is to change the place of use, and to allow for the sale of bottled spring water to a commercial plant, in Reno, Nevada, and to correct the point of diversion.**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of unnamed springs as heretofore granted under Permit 23632 Certificate 8640 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23632 Certificate 8640 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62628 and 62629 shall not exceed 27.45 million gallons annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the flow of the springs measured at the point of diversion and the amount of water placed to beneficial use. These records must be submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

Any water provided to the water bottling plant would be the first service curtailed or reduced if necessary to provide water delivery to the permittee's other customers as specified in the permittee's April 18, 1997 water budget.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.225 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 9.2 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 16, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 16, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 16, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 16, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
