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The applicant Mogul Water Company, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Truckee River Claim 102 in the September 8, 1944 Final Decree in United State v. Orr Ditch Water Company, In Equity, No. A-3 in the United States District Court

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1. The source of water is Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.301 cfs not to exceed 42.18 acre feet annually
3. The water to be used for municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point See Exhibit "A" attached hereto and map supporting Application #58882 on file with the Nevada State Engineer
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., more specifically located on the Highland Ditch which is the point of diversion under this Orr Ditch Decree (Map not required. See Item #15.) See Exhibit "A"
7. Proposed place of use See Application #62141 and supporting map for SPPCo. place of use. See Exhibit "B" attached.
8. Existing place of use Decreed place of use. (Refer to Tracy Taylor letter of September 17, 1996. Copy attached. Map not required. See Item #15.)
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Water will be diverted by existing Sierra Pacific facilities, treated and placed into Sierra's existing distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works in excess of \$50 million
13. Estimated time required to construct works existing
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use ten years

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 102, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.30 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 42.18 acre-feet as decreed.



**Proposed Point of Diversion**

The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

**STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

**HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

**IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

**NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW1/4 NE1/4) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

**ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

The point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.


**ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the submittal of the Judgement and Decree Case No. CV95-01770 in the Second Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Washoe, adjudicating ownership of certain water rights the State Engineer has updated its records to show ownership of these certain water rights as described in Exhibit "A". The Judgement and Decree clearly defined the ownership and acre-foot duty for a portion of Claims 102 and 142 but did not address all items. The State Engineer has used all information on file with this office to determine the Place of Use and the corresponding permit number or claim number appurtenant to each owner of record. There are still certain owners of record that have an undefined Place of Use as stated on Exhibit "A" and are hereby required to file applications to change the water right or provide information showing the exact Place of Use of the reverted water within 90 days of this letter. Failure to do so will result in the State Engineer not accepting the will serve letters based on these water rights.




