The applicant International Silica Corporation, hereby makes application for permission to change the Place of Use and Point of Diversion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 52614

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 353.85 MGA not to exceed 1.5 cfs

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52614 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52614 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62691, 62692 and 62693 shall not exceed 1,327.275 acre-feet annually.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1,085,955 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
October 2, 1997

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:
November 2, 1997

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
October 2, 1998

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
November 2, 1998
