The applicant Incline Village General Improvement District, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 18558, Certificate 6149

1. The source of water is Lake Tahoe
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.25 c.f.s., 3.1 mga
3. The water to be used for Municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point (Lot 1 extended) SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.16N., R.18E., MDM, or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 16 bears North 22° 50' 57" West, 2487.93 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 23, T.16N., R.18E., MDM (extended) or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 23 bears North 7° 39' 01" West, 4166.59 feet
7. Proposed place of use Within Sections 1, 2, 3, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 21, 22 and 23, W $\frac{1}{2}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 8, W $\frac{1}{2}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 12, E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 18, portions of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, all lying within Washoe County, Nevada, T.16N., R.18E., MDM

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of Lake Tahoe heretofore granted under Permit 18558 Certificate 6149 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18558 Certificate 6149 and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 19393; 40511 Certificate 14298; 40512 Certificate 13536; 40515 Certificate 13537; 43042 Certificate 13539; 52244 Certificate 14299; 58395; 58396; 62044; 62045; 62046; 62047; 62048; 62049, and 62698 shall not exceed 4,027.67 acre-feet annually.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 3.1 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 9, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 9, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 9, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 9, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
