The applicant James Leland Wallace, hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under permit 30952, cert. 9266

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.643 c.f.s., 152.48 AFY
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 9 bears S 38° 25' W a distance of 79 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Sec. 9 bears S 46° 04' E a distance of 1894.80 feet
7. Proposed place of use SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. 110.64 acres
8. Existing place of use 9.52 ac in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.
9.53 ac in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.
9.53 ac in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.
9.53 ac in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 9, T.4S., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30952 Certificate 9266 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30952 Certificate 9266 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62814, 62815, 62816, and 62817 shall not exceed 515.04 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 110.64 acres.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.643 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 152.44 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.655 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 23, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 23, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 23, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 23, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 23, 2000
