The applicant Donald E. Bently, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 56471

1. The source of water is An Underground Source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0055 CFS not to exceed 4.0 Acre Feet annually
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic (no change)
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T12N, R20E, MDB&M or at a point from which the north $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 28, T12N, R20E, MDB&M bears N75 $^{\circ}$ 35' 00"E, a distance of 5468.62 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, T12N, R19E, MDB&M or at a point from which the north $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 9 bears N10 $^{\circ}$ 56' 32"E, a distance of 2384.51 feet.
7. Proposed place of use Portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T12N, R20E MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada
8. Existing place of use Portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, T12N, R19E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drilled well, submersible pump and pressure tank and a pipeline to the place of use.
12. Estimated cost of works Appoximately \$4,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works 1 Year
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 1 Year

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15. Remarks: Water will be used for two (2) trailers. Please use the map filed under Permit 56471 to show the existing point of diversion and place of use. A new map is enclosed which shows the proposed point of diversion and place of use. The new map is also submitted to support Proofs of Appropriation 07308 and 07309 and Application 62818

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56471 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56471 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0055 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
July 3, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:
August 3, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
July 3, 1999


