The applicant TOM ISOLA AND THE TAI ARABIAN RANCH, hereby make application for permission to change the Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 58104

1. The source of water is Underground, Moapa Valley
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.173 cfs (125.0 acre feet annually)
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T.15S., R.67E., MDM, or at a point whence the SE Corner of said Section 21 bears S. 04 43' 15"E. a distance of 406 ft.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T.15S., R.67E., MDM, or at a point whence the SE Corner of said Section 21 bears S. 04 43'15"E. a distance of 406 feet.
7. Proposed place of use is within Portions of Sections 21 and 22, T.15S., R.67E., MDM. Refer to Attachment "A" for Proposed Places of Use.
8. Existing place of use is within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T. 15 S., R. 67 E., MDM, a total of 25 Acres.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works a drilled and cased well with pump, motor and meter at the well head, with pipelines to the place of use.
12. Estimated cost of works \$2,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works Complete, including an 8 5/8 inch cased well with pump, meter, pipelines and valves to the place of use
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 2 Years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 58104 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 58104 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permits 62846 and 62847 are limited to the irrigation of 50 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.173 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 125.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 5, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

April 5, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 5, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 5, 2000



Item 15. Remarks

The Duty under this permit will be commingled with the Duty under Permit 52265 (Cert. 13356) to more efficiently serve the overall needs of the TAI Arabian Ranch. The water from both Permits will be used for irrigation and domestic purposes for a total acreage not to exceed 50 combined acres. The topography of the west side of the ranch makes it difficult to specify large areas to be placed under irrigation. This Change of Place of Use will give the Permittee more options to efficiently use the water under the Permit
