

APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION, MANNER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

The applicant Geneerco, inc - a California Corp., hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use for a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 30411, Certificate 9788

1. The source of water is an underground source in Nye County, Nv.
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.525 C.F.S., not to exceed 148.55 A.F.A..
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes.
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic purposes.
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the SW. Corner of said Section 23 bears S. 44° 21' 58" W, a distance of 1893 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the SE. corner of said Section 23 bears N 42° 45' E., a distance of 1847.67 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 69.11 acres within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.M..

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30411, Certificate 9788; is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30411, Certificate 9788 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62918, 62919, 63151, 63152, 63153, and 63174 shall not exceed 559.8 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 111.96 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.525 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 148.55 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

October 1, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

November 1, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 1, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 1, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


