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The applicant Washoe County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Nevada hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Claim No. 209 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decree entered by the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada in that certain action entitled "The United States of Americia, Plaintiff vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, Et Al Defendants," in Equity docket No. A-3.

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1. The source of water is Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.039 cfs - 12.6375 AC ft
3. The water to be used for Municipal Use
4. The water heretofore permitted for As Decreed
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Refer to Exhibit "A"
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE1/4 NW1/4 Section 19 T19N, R19E, MDM, or at Point from which the Northwest Corner of Section 20 T19N, R19E, MDM, Bears S 88°05' E., A Distance of 2620.00 feet (Lake Ditch)
7. Proposed place of use See Exhibit "B" and Supporting Maps Filed under Application #'s 57410 & 62187.
8. Existing place of use Lot 77 = 0.99 acres, Lot 110 = 0.99 acres, and a Portion of Lot 113 = 0.40 acres, in the NW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 31 and Lot 115 = 0.99 acres in the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 31 T19N, R20E, MDM.
9. Use will be from As Decreed to As Decreed of each year.
10. Use was permitted from As Decreed to As Decreed of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Water will be Diverted by Existing SPPCo. Facilities, Treated and Placed into Existing Distribution System.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 209, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit also changes a portion of Claim 210 of the Truckee River Final Decree.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.039 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 12.64 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:



The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

**STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

**HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

**IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:**

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

**NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):**

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW1/4 NE1/4) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

**ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.

**ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Southwest corner of said Section 17 bears South 44°40' West, a distance of 3,211.00 feet.
