The applicant Sierra Stone Company, dba All-Lite Aggregate, hereby makes application for permission to change the Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 61645

1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 1.0 c.f.s., 110.2 AFA
3. The water to be used for Industrial
4. The water heretofore permitted for Industrial
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.19N., R.21E., MDM, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 10 bears South 41° 10' West, 4093 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within no change
7. Proposed place of use within Sections 3, 4, and 10, T.19N., R.21E., MDM
8. Existing place of use within Section 9, (excepting the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), T.19N., R.21E., MDM
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works well, pump and motor, pipeline and storage facilities
12. Estimated cost of works \$50,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works well as drilled
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use n/a

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61645 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61645 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on August 10, 1998 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 110.2 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
