

DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER

The protests to this application are hereby upheld in part and the application is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no unappropriated groundwater at the source of the supply, the proposed use would conflict with existing rights in the Order 1169 basins and the proposed use of the water would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest in that it would threaten the water resources upon which the endangered Moapa dace are dependent. No ruling is made on the merits of the remaining protest grounds.

The applicant **Ron Smilow**, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an **underground source**
2. The amount of water applied for is **0.0062 C.F.S** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Purposes**

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 19 South, Range 60 East, M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the East 1/4 of said Section 14 bears South 51°28'17" East 299.30 FT.**
6. Place of Use **SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 19 South, Range 60 East, M.D.B.&M approximately 1.9 acres. See map filed under cancelled permit number 55528**
7. Use will begin about **January 1st** and end about **December 31st**, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Well, pump, electric motor, domestic water lines from four houses to 1500 gallon water storage tank and meter.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$12,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **five years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **seven years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to the State Engineer's amended order 1054 dated April 15, 1992, to provide water service to four homes.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0062 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.46 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 27, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 27, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 27, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 27, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
