The applicant Washoe County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner of Use, and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 36390, Certificate 11629

1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 cfs, but not to exceed 0.3802 MGA
3. The water to be used for Municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 54⁰ 31' 36" E., a distance of 1,539.98 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 33⁰ 01' E., a distance of 2,459.0 feet.
7. Proposed place of use E $\frac{1}{2}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23; NW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24; N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26; all in T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
8. Existing place of use S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, pump, storage tank, and distribution lines.
12. Estimated cost of works \$35,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works Complete (see Permit 59703)
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years per NRS 533.380
15. Remarks: Please refer to map filed 58615 for the proposed point of diversion and place of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 36390, Certificate 11629 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 36390, Certificate 11629 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 34738, 58615, 59703, 63357 and 63358 shall not exceed 21.0965 million gallons annually.

Any well drilled under Permit 30097, Certificate 11167 and Permit 36390, Certificate 11629 shall be plugged in accordance with the Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 534.420, "Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling" within 60 days from the issuance of this permit.

The issuance of this permit totally abrogates Permit 36390, Certificate 11629.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.3802 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 11, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 11, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 11, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 11, 2003


