The applicant **Moapa Valley Water District**, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **six (6) second-feet**
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet **4344 AFA**
3. The water to be used for **municipal**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **Within the NE4 of the SE4 of Section 26, Township 12 South, Range 65 East, MDB&M; located North 34° 42' 56" West 7270.03 feet from the NW Corner of Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 66 East MDB&M.**
6. Place of Use (**see appended sheet**)
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **submersible pump and motor; construct approximately 13 miles of pipeline.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$1,000,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **one (1) year**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **five (5) years**
12. Remarks: **Additional development of new water resources is necessary to meet anticipated shortfalls of fresh potable water needed to service**
