The applicant **Indian Springs Sewer Company**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 55847**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.67 second-feet**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **in Tract 43, T.16S., R.56E., M.D.M. from which point the NE corner of Tract 46 bears S. 77°35'34" E, 224.11'**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **Tract 43, T.16S., R.56E., MDM from which point the NE corner of tract 43 bears N. 65°56'18"E., 1012 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Same as Item No. 8.**
8. Existing place of use **Sections, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8. 9, 10, 15, 16, 17 and 18 and Tracts 37 thru 49, inclusive all in Township 16 South Range 56 East M.D.M. Clark County, Nevada.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 55847 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 55847 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 20628, Certificate 7447; 34725, Certificate 9819; 38859, Certificate 11398; 49045 and 63469 shall not exceed 235.905 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.67 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 158.056 million gallons annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

September 12, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

October 12, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 12, 2002

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 12, 2002


