The applicant Harry J. Williams, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 53923

1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.11 c.f.s. (67.94 acre feet)
3. The water to be used for Recreation (Golf Course Irrigation)
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation, Domestic and Stock Water
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 12 bears N. 87° 07' 25" E., a distance of 2756.69
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 6, bears N. 27° 48' 17" E, a distance of 2557.2'
7. Proposed place of use NW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
8. Existing place of use S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. Area to be removed from the Place of Use is the Westerly 305.25 feet of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and a portion of the Westerly 305.25 feet of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ within said Section 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. as further described on the supporting Map.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drilled well, pump & motor to storage ponds and Golf Course distribution system
12. Estimated cost of works \$500,00.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 Years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 Years
15. Remarks: The area being removed from the Existing Place of Use is a portion of the Place of Use defined as that held by Mr. Williams within the Court Judgment attached hereto.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53923 which changed the point of diversion of water heretofore appropriated under claim of vested right as evidenced by Proof of Appropriation of Water 04884, is issued with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The state reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to any determination of the waters of an underground source that may be made under adjudication proceedings under NRS 533.090 through 533.320.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 63474, 63475 and 63476 shall not exceed 67.94 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 61324, 62081, 62110, 63474, 63475 and 63476 shall not exceed 494.74 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 67.94 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 13, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 13, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 13, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 13, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


