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The applicant Wanda C. Wright, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit No. 55975

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1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.00532 cfs, 3.84 afa
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 29 bears South 72° 04' 05" West a distance of 1009.34 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the south quarter corner of said Section 29 bears North 00° 18' 05" East a distance of 2571 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 0.96 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.M., exact location to be determined later. (Assessor's Parcel Number 77-360-08)
8. Existing place of use 0.97 acres within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.M..
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, pump, meter and pipeline irrigation system.
12. Estimated cost of works \$30,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 55975 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 55975 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 63519 and 63520 shall not exceed 4.96 acre-feet annually.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 0.97 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00532 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 3.84 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 20, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

April 20, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 20, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 20, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


