Item 15 - Remarks

Sierra Stone Company, dba All-Lite Aggregate leases the land at Washington Mountain from the permittee. They have continually encountered problems with well production. The well under Permit 56923 has failed to the point that it is no longer of any use and production in the well under Permits 62274 and 62275 has dropped by more than 50 percent.

This application proposes to move water into another well site located northwest of wells under Permits 56923, 62274 and 62275. The proposed place of use does not change due to the reduction in the place of use under Permit 56923 as outlined in the June 27, 1996 letter to the State Engineer. Please use map on file under Application 62274 to support the place of use and attached sketch to support the point of diversion.

A waiver to drill an exploratory well will be requested to determine the quantity of water at the proposed point of diversion. If a satisfactory well is found, an application to change for a "permanent" water right will be filed.
