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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of Lake Tahoe heretofore granted under Permit 61784 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61784 and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0518 cubic foot per second, but not to exceed 22.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 6, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 6, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 6, 2008

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 6, 2008



## Response to Item 5.

The water is to be diverted at the following point within Lot 1 extended (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 16, T. 16 N., R. 18 E., M.D.M. at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 16 bears N. 22° 50' 57" W. a distance of 2,487.93 feet.

## Response to Item 6.

The existing point of diversion is located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 4 of Section 15, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.M. at a point from which the meander corner common to Sections 15 and 22, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.M. bears S. 47° 30' E. a distance of 348 feet.
