The applicant Oro Nevada Mining Company, Inc., hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.0624 second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Stockwatering
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered 2000 cattle
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.29N., R.50E., MDM or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears North 73° 31' West, 4212 feet.
6. Place of Use NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.29N., R.50E., MDM
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31 of each year.
8. Description of proposed works well, pump and motor
9. Estimated cost of works \$5000
10. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 4 years
12. Remarks: The purpose of this application is to establish a formal permit for stockwater use from a well that has been in existence at least 25 years. Water is made available for wildlife at the source.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 63827, 63828, 63829, 63830, 63831, 63832, and 63833 shall not exceed that sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0624 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

April 5, 2002

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

May 5, 2002

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

April 5, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 5, 2004
