The applicant Virgin Valley Water District, hereby make application for permission to change the The point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 14471, Certificate No. 4358

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.10 cfs
3. The water to be used for quasi municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for farmstead and domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T13S, R70E, MDM or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said section 35 bears S 55° 39' 43" E, a distance of 773.7 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, T13S, R70E MDB&M, or at a point from which corner No. 4 tract 44 of section 35, T13S, R70E, bears N 19° 41' W, 2,228 feet.
7. Proposed place of use All of T13S, R67E; T14S, R67E; T13S, R68E; T14S, R68E; T13S, R69E; T14S, R69E; T13S, R70E; T14S, R70E; T13S, R71E; and T14S, R71E; MDM and portions of T15S, R69E; T15S, R70E; and T15S, R71E; MDM Clark County, Nevada and Section 32, T40N, R16W; and Section 5, T39N, R16W; G&SRM. Mohave County, Arizona
8. Existing place of use Community of Bunkerville within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, section 25 T13S, R70E, MDB&M
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drill new 24 inch steel cased well to a depth of 2,000± feet and equip with appropriate pump and motor and discharge through a 10" pipe to the Bunkerville water distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works \$500,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years
15. Remarks: The water appropriated under this permit will be distributed in the town of Bunkerville to approximately 300 domestic customers and will be used to supplement domestic water to the City of Mesquite during periods of high demand.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 14471 Certificate 4358 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 14471, Certificate 4358 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any well drilled under Permit 14471, Certificate 4358 shall be plugged in accordance with the Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 534.420, "Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling" within 60 days from the issuance of this permit.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 14347, Certificate 7270; 17833, Certificate 5495, 20361, Certificate 5922; 41120, Certificate 13575; Permits 41122, 50172, 50865, 51271, 51272, 51306, 52015, 52017, 52333, 52952, 53026, 53027, 54154, 56244, 56981, 61594, 61595, 61975 and 63879 shall not exceed 2,943.6 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 23.6 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
July 28, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:
August 28, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
July 28, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
August 28, 2003
