The applicant City of Refuge, a non-profit corporation, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 55256

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.08 CFS, 8.0 AFS
3. The water to be used for irrigation purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 14 bears N. 00 $^{\circ}$ 58' 24" E., a distance of 880.6 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears N. 67 $^{\circ}$ 45' 29" W., a distance of 2,409.62 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 2.0 acres within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., Douglas County, Nevada.
8. Existing place of use within E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, all within T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., Douglas County, Nevada.
9. Use will be from April 1st to October 15th of each year.
10. Use was permitted from April 1st to October 15th of each year.
11. Description of proposed works drilled well, pump, motor and irrigation system.
12. Estimated cost of works \$25,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works three years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use five years
15. Remarks: The purpose of this application is to transfer those water rights donated by the Jacobsen Family Trust to property owned and controlled by City of Refuge for the purposes stated herein.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 55256 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 55256 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The place of use of this permit is limited to the irrigation of 2.0 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 8.0 acre-feet per season, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

July 30, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

August 30, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 30, 2002

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 30, 2002

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 30, 2002
