The applicant William "Hal" Kennington, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #46936, Certificate #13138

1. The source of water is Underground Source
2. The amount of water to be changed 2 acre feet 0.0028 CFS
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Within the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 15, T19S, R60E, MDM, or at a point from which the center one-quarter corner of said Section 15, T19S, R60E, MDM, bears South 28° 36' 00" West a distance of 1119.0 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within The Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, T19S, R60E, MDM, or at a point from which the center one-quarter corner (C $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 26, T19S, R60E, MDM, bears North 67° 23' West a distance of 1127.0 feet
7. Proposed place of use Southeast (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 15, T19S, R60E, MDM
8. Existing place of use Portion of the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, T19S, R60E, MDM, 0.4 acre to be removed from irrigation.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing 8 inch steel cased well, 5 hp submersible pump, piping, wiring, booster, pump, totalizing meter, 2,5000 gal. storage tank, and appurtenances.
12. Estimated cost of works None
13. Estimated time required to construct works One Year
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Five years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 46936, Certificate 13138 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 46936, Certificate 13138 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0028 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 5, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 5, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 5, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 5, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
