

DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER

The protests to this application are hereby upheld in part and the application is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no unappropriated groundwater at the source of the supply, the proposed use would conflict with existing rights in the Order 1169 basins and the proposed use of the water would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest in that it would threaten the water resources upon which the endangered Moapa dace are dependent. No ruling is made on the merits of the remaining protest grounds.

The applicant Dry Lake Water, L.L.C., hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source in Basin 217
2. The amount of water applied for is 10 second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for quasi municipal
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated n/a
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered n/a
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") (see No. 12)
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed n/a
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream n/a
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16, T16S, R63E, MDM at a point from which the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 16 bears N 40⁰ 23' W, 111 feet
6. Place of Use (see attached list)
7. Use will begin about Jan 1st and end about Dec 31st of each year.
8. Description of proposed works water is to be diverted from wells through pipelines to storage tanks in place of use (see map). Design of system depends on amount and location of water developed.
9. Estimated cost of works unknown
10. Estimated time required to construct works five years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use five years
12. Remarks: Dry Lake Water, L.L.C. intends to be the distributor of water to the commercial/industrial developments in the Apex Industrial Park. The applicant has applied for water rights in five enclosed basins, for

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40,000 acre feet on each application. The applicant is requesting, however, a total of 40,000 acre feet combined from all applications for use in the defined place of use. The applicant intends to tap the deep carbonate aquifer.
