The applicant Donald R. & Simmie D. Travis, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place of Use and Manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under State on Nevada Permit No. 35133, Certificate No. 11072

1. The source of water is An Underground Source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.95 c.f.s.
3. The water to be used for Domestic & Quasi-municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., from a point that bears S 71 $^{\circ}$ 29' 18" E a distance of 1434.61 feet to the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., from a point that bears S 86 $^{\circ}$ 54' 00" E a distance of 2596.80 feet to the SE corner of said Section 6.
7. Proposed place of use the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.
8. Existing place of use a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., a total of 12.50 acres to be removed from irrigation.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, Pump and Distribution System
12. Estimated cost of works \$20,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years
15. Remarks: The total combined duty of this application and application #64071 shall not exceed 50.00 ac. ft. annually.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 35133, Certificate 11072 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 35133, Certificate 11072 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 64071 and 64072 shall not exceed 50.0 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any well drilled under this permit shall be drilled in what has been described in the United States Geological Survey Water Supply Paper 2263 as the intermediate alluvial aquifer. In no instance shall the seal on this well be less than 100 feet below ground level.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.195 cubic feet per second.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

September 14, 2001

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

October 14, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

September 14, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 14, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


