WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA**

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The applicant Board of Nye County Commissioners, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.25 (C.F.S.) second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal
4. If use is for:
  - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
  - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
  - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
  - (d) Power:
    - (1) Horsepower developed
    - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, T.17S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., whence the north one quarter corner of said Section 7 bears N. 4 $^{\circ}$  57"W., 2524.23 feet distant.
6. Place of Use Lot 13A & 15 of Block 1 of the Forty Bar Estates Subdivision, as filed in the Nye County Recorder's Office, as document map no. 32393, and being Assessor's Parcel No. 2118104 & 12, and being situated within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, T.17S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., Amargosa Valley, Nevada
7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st of each year.
8. Description of proposed works Well is presently drilled and equipped under an existing domestic use
9. Estimated cost of works \$5,000 to \$10,000 for piping & equipment
10. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years
12. Remarks: One fire house on Lot 13A, together with one residence on Lot 15 (see map) will be served for an expected total consumption of 1,300,000 gallons annually.

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## APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.30 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

October 8, 2001

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

November 8, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

October 8, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 8, 2004


