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The applicant Michael C. Dermody, hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #61160

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1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0313 CFS not to exceed 5.0 acre feet annually
3. The water to be used for irrigation, domestic and stock watering
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation, domestic and stock watering
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the North one quarter corner of said Section 12 bears N. 83 $^{\circ}$  39' 40" E. a distance of 765.83 feet (See Map filed with Application #57848.)
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T.18N. R.20E., M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the South one quarter of said Section 17 bears S. 09 $^{\circ}$  06' 54" W. a distance of 1607.56 feet (See Map filed with Application #61160)
7. Proposed place of use NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, T.18N., R.19E. M.D.B.&M. Parcel "A" Parcel Map 2913 APN 040-650-19.
8. Existing place of use Section 17, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  - 8.2 Acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  - 2.4 Acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  - 9.4 Acres Total 20.0 Acres
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing well, pump, motor and meter. Existing ditch system will deliver water to proposed place of use.
12. Estimated cost of works Existing
13. Estimated time required to construct works Existing
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use three years
15. Remarks: Water will be commingled with Decreed Truckee River and water under Permit #57848.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61160 which changed the point of diversion of water heretofore appropriated under claim of vested right as evidenced by Proof of Appropriation of Water 04689, is issued with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to any determination of the waters of an underground source that may be made under adjudication proceedings under NRS 533.090 through 533.320.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57848 and 64212 shall not exceed 7.98 acre-feet and is limited to the irrigation of 1.99 acres within the described place of use.

This permit is issued supplemental to Truckee River Claim 185.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0313 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.
