The applicant **Ramparts, Inc.**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit 59047

1. The source of water is **Las Vegas Artesian Basin (underground)**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0166 cfs, not to exceed 3 million gallons annually**
3. The water to be used for **commercial and domestic purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **commercial and domestic purposes**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T21S, R61E, MDM**, or at a point from which the center of said Section 29 bears **N 86° 50' 50" W**, a distance of **1,299.67 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T21S, R61E, MDM**, or at a point from which the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 29 bears **S 58° 33' 28" E**, a distance of **1,875.48 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T21S, R61E, MDM**
8. Existing place of use **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and portion of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T21S, R61E, MDM**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Well, motor, pump and meter which was constructed under Permit 25324.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$100,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **one year**
15. Remarks: **This application changes a portion of Permit 59047 to an existing well under Permit 25324. Certificate 8116 for construction water and dust control for a new Hotel/Casino. This existing well is within the new Hotel area and will be capped after grading is finished. This existing Point of Diversion and Plase of Use is shown on Map to Accompany Application 59047. The proposed Point of Diversion is shown on Map to Accompany Application 25324. The Hotel/Casino will be under construction for one more year and this temporary is to renew 63092T.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 59047 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 59047 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on September 30, 1999 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0166 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 3.0 million gallons annually.


