The applicant Lloyd M. Martin hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No 35708, Certificate No 10651

1. The source of water is Underground Source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.338 CFS, 88 Acre ft.
3. The water to be used for irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, T20N R53E MDB&M., whence the East 1/4 corner of said Section 4 bears N 45⁰ 00' E 1840 feet distant
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within in Lot 16 of Section 4, T.20N., R53E MDB&M., whence the NE corner of said Section 4 bears N 29⁰ 15' 00" E 2665.0 feet distant
7. Proposed place of use Portions of the W1/2 SE1/4 of Section 4, T.20N., R.53E. MDB&M 22 acres
8. Existing place of use Lot Nos. 15 and 16 and the S1/2 NE1/4 of Section 4, T20N., R53E., MDB&M., 153.6 acres
9. Use will be from Jan 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works The water will be pumped from a well into a spinkler system.
12. Estimated cost of works 5,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 1 year
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 35708, Certificate 10651 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 35708, Certificate 10651 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 19371, Certificate 6990; 64315 and 64317 shall not exceed 502.40 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.338 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 88.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 27, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 27, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 27, 2002

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 27, 2002

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 27, 2002
