**APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC
WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA**

The applicant Nevada State Lands Division, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source in Three Lakes Valley, Clark County, Nevada
2. The amount of water applied for is 3.0 second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal (Penal Institution)
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") See Item #12
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point Within the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 57 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada or at a point from which the Northeast (NE) corner of said Section 32 bears North 10° 21' 39" East a distance of 1,418.26 feet
6. Place of Use is within Sections 31, 32 and 33, Township 16 South, Range 57 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada
7. Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st of each year.
8. Description of proposed works well, pump, motor, distribution piping, meter
9. Estimated cost of works \$10,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works existing well
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years
12. Remarks: Water supply for Quasi-Municipal (Penal Institution) Use, that the total combined duty of Permits 38655, Certificate 12656; Permit 42636, Certificate 11365; Permit 55421 and the permits issued under 56135 and 56136 shall not exceed 513.19 million gallons annually

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(1,574.92 acre-feet annually) as per Ruling 4177 dated 3/29/95 See Notice of Intent No. 16218, Well Driller's Report by B. L. Weber Group, Inc., 8108 Bay Harbor Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89128.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 38655, Certificate 12656; 42636, Certificate 11635; 55421, 56135, 56136, 64453, 64454 and 64455 shall not exceed 1,574.92 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1,574.92 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

August 16, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

September 16, 2000

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 16, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 16, 2004


