The applicant Larry Olsen (2/3 interest), Gary & Sharon Graves (1/3 interest), hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60387, 60388, 60389, 60390, 60391, 60392, 60393, 60394 and 64460 shall not exceed 4,145.85 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 1,096.06 acres.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.83 cubic feet per second.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

July 30, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

August 30, 2000

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

July 30, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 30, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 30, 2001

12. Remarks: This is the same well as Permits 60390,60392, 60394. This well is used in conjunction with wells under permits 60387-60389, 60391 and 60393 to irrigate the same place of use. The purpose of this application is to bring the allowable diversion rate up to what this new well is capable of producing. The total annual usage under this permit and permits 60387 through 60394 will not exceed what is currently allowed under the permits. The additional diversion requested under this well will allow for better irrigation management practices on the property. Several pivot sprinklers have been installed on the property, with a consequent reduction in total irrigated acreage. It is anticipated that when the actual Proofs of Beneficial Use are filed, the total acreage will be less than 1096.06 acres.
