The applicant Palomino Valley Estates, Inc., hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit 54413

1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.1111 cfs, 20.0 acre feet annually
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the southeast corner of said Section 16 bears South 43° 46' 06" East a distance of 1860.90 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.22N., R.20E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the south $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 36 bears South 45° West a distance of 1000 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 5.0 acres within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., the exact location to be determined later.
8. Existing place of use within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.22N., R.20E., M.D.M., as shown on map supporting Permit 54413.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing drilled well, pump and pipeline.
12. Estimated cost of works \$50,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54413 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54413 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 40587, Certificate 11180; 54467, 54468, 61942, 62598, 62599, 62600 and 64501 shall not exceed 164.0 acre-feet annually and is limited to the irrigation of 41.0 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.111 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 20.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.


