The applicant Washoe County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place of Use, and Manner of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under a Portion of Claim No. 434 Final Decree, United States of America Vs. Orr Water Ditch Company et.al.

- 1. The source of water is Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 1.84 acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for as Decreed.
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Please refer to attached Exhibit "A" Multiple points of diversion consisting of SPPCO's points of diversion and Washoe County's Point of Diversion associated with Permit 53249. Please refer to maps 58882 and 53249.

8. Existing place of use Washoe County Assessor Parcel Numbers 013-464-23, 013-464-22, and 013-464-21 located in the SW1/4, SE1/4 Section 13, T.19N., R.19E. 0.43 Acres
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from As decreed.
11. Description of proposed works Existing facilities associated with SPPCO's and Washoe County water systems
12. Estimated cost of works Existing

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years per NRS 533.380
15. Remarks: For domestic service within Washoe County's service area pursuant to County ordinance and requirements. Sierra Pacific Power Company (S.P.P.Co) is the wholesale supplier to Washoe County for the specific purpose of diverting, treating, and delivering the water required under the wholesale agreement.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 434, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0065 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1.84 acre-feet as decreed.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

November 19, 2005

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

December 19, 2005

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

November 19, 2014

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

December 19, 2014



The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):

The existing point of diversion is situated within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW1/4 NE1/4) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE1/4 SE1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.

ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):

The point of diversion is situated within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion the Southwest corner of said Section 17 bears South 44°40' West, a distance of 3,211.00 feet.
