The applicant The Bently Family Limited Partnership, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 52962

1. The source of water is an underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.302 CFS not to exceed 30.4 acre feet per season.
3. The water to be used for irrigation (No Change).
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation.
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, T13N, R20E, MDB&M or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 27, T13N, R20E, MDB&M bears S 53 $^{\circ}$ 29' 06" W, 8163.04 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T13N, R20E, MDB&M or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 2 bears N 50 $^{\circ}$ 04' 21" W, 2320.0 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 7.60 acres within portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 in T13N, R20E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada (APN 23-291-01 & 02).
8. Existing place of use 7.60 acres within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T13N, R20E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada (APN 23-510-01 & 02).
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from May 1 to October 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drilled well, pump and motor, storage tank and sprinkler systems.
12. Estimated cost of works Approximately \$150,000.
13. Estimated time required to construct works Well has a 16 inch casing to 570 feet drilled by Parsons Drilling, Inc. and completed in March 1991.
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years.
15. Remarks: Please use the map filed under Permit 52961 to show the existing point of diversion and existing place of use. Please use

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the map filed under Permit 55356 to show the proposed point of diversion and the map filed under Application 64528 to show the proposed place of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52692 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52692 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 7.6 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.302 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 30.4 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.


