The applicant **ROBERT DIPPNER**, hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of use & manner of use of a portion of Permit No. 11241, Certificate 3388 of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 11241, Certificate 3388

1. The source of water is Underground Source, Las Vegas Basin, Clark County, Nevada
2. The amount of water to be changed One (1) Acre Foot
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.M, Clark County, Nevada, from which the north one-quarter Section corner of said Section 28, bears N 44 $^{\circ}$ 09' 31" East, a distance of 1215.01 ft. (Said Diversion Point is located in Lot 23, Block 2 of Meikle Manor Tract 4, Book 4, page 10 of Plats, Clark County Recorder's office)
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.M., Clark County, Nevada, from which the Northwest Section Corner of said Section 36, bears N 46 $^{\circ}$ 03' 00" W, 1921.3 ft.
7. Proposed place of use NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.M., Clark County, Nevada
8. Existing place of use SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.M., Clark County, Nevada (85.56' x 315' = 0.619 Acres with 4.48 A.F. existing). Stripping 19.10' x 315' = 0.138 Ac with 1.0 A.F. leaving 3.48 A.F.
9. Use will be from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing drilled well, pump, motor and appurtenances.
12. Estimated cost of works Existing facilities
13. Estimated time required to construct works Existing facilities
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11241, Certificate 3388 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11241, Certificate 3388 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0014 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 16, 2001

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 16, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

May 16, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 16, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


