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The applicant **Loeb Enterprises Limited Liability Company**, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **3.667 CFS not to exceed 588.89 acre feet/annually** second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Recreation (Golf Course Irrigation & domestic.)**
4. If use is for:
  - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **172.1375**
  - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
  - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
  - (d) Power:
    - (1) Horsepower developed
    - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **SE¼ SE¼ of Section 12, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the Southeast corner of said Section 12 bears S. 39°48'46" E. a distance of 1530.23 feet**
6. Place of Use **See Exhibit "A" attached hereto.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31**, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Water will be diverted from a well with pump and motor and into storage ponds and distributed by means of the golf course irrigation system.**
9. Estimated cost of works **in excess of \$500,000.00**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **three years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **ten years**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 61324, 62080, 62081, 62110, 63321, 63474, 63475, 63476, 64740, 65574 and 65575 shall not exceed 609.985 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.228 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 571.26 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 13, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 13, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

May 13, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 13, 2004

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



**ITEM 12 REMARKS:**

The purpose of this Application is to establish a second point of diversion for water permitted or applied for under Permits #61324, 62081, 62110, 63321, 63474, 63475 and 63476 and Application #62080. The Applicant proposes to construct a second well in order to have a reliable source of water available should an electrical, mechanical or other failure occur that would render the existing well inoperative. Millions of dollars have been invested in the construction of the golf Course and it is prudent water management to have a second source of supply available.
